

COVID-19 and Westminster FCU

Several metro area counties transitioned, on Sunday May 16, 2021, to **Level Clear** which is the least restrictive level on the Colorado COVID-19 dial. Level Clear allows businesses to operate at 100% capacity with no mitigation requirements, aside from the state's indoor mask mandate.

Denver, **Jefferson**, Broomfield, Boulder, **Adams** and Arapahoe counties have all moved to **Level Clear**, according to state health officials.

In April, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment lifted the COVID-19 framework, allowing individual health departments to implement their own restrictions.

Westminster Federal Credit Union has been monitoring the COVID-19 case numbers, since May 16th, and there have not only been no increase in the number of cases reported and the cases & hospitalizations continue to decline.

Thus, as of June 1, 2021, Westminster Federal Credit Union is lifting the mandated face mask policy in our office and will operate with no mitigation requirements.

We will continue to monitor this situation and reserve the right to modify. We also encourage and request that those that are not vaccinated continue to wear masks in our office, to protect our employees, and to receive the vaccination.
